

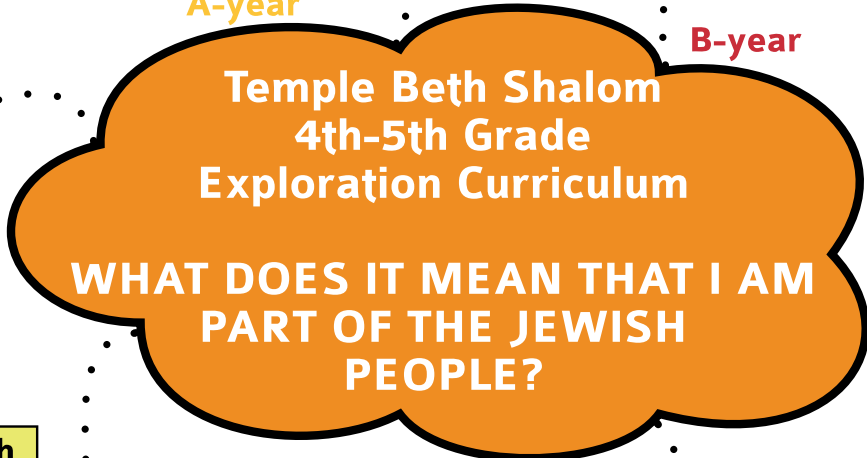
When we learn about our Jewish past, we learn about our Jewish selves and our Jewish present.
