IN FINDYOURSUMMER.ORG AMBASSADORS PROGRAM

WHAT IS FINDYOURSUMMER.ORG AMBASSADORS?

A program aimed at furthering the number of New York Area high-school aged teens exploring and enrolling in Jewish summer experiences.

Ambassadors will be incentivized for each teen (up to 5 teens) that enrolls in a summer program listed on FindYourSummer.org for the first time as a direct result of the Ambassador's referral.

HOW CAN THE AMBASSADOR PROGRAM HELP ME?

It will equip youth professionals with the tools to better engage teens in conversations about their summer plan through workshops,

Through workshops, you will emerge with a better understanding of the Jewish summer experience landscape and scholarship opportunities for Jewish teens in Westchester, Long Island and the Five Boroughs.

REQUIREMENTS

Each Ambassador will engage **15 eligible teens** in conversations held between **November + May**:

- 1) Capture data on teen meeting
- 2) Follow up meeting with **Summer Planner** suggestions
- 3) Cross-denominational promotional required

Attendance at two one-day workshops (held in December & February)

30-minute Monthly check-in calls
December- May (6 total)

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Eligible teens are defined as **Jewish teens who are currently in 8th - 12th grades** (meaning for the approaching summer they will be rising Freshman through Seniors)

Eligible teens **can not enroll in a previously attended summer program**

PAYMENT

\$1,000 to participating institutions (\$500 to synagogue, \$500 to professional)

\$250 bonus to the Ambassador per teen enrolled in a program listed on FindYourSummer.org (up to 5 teens)

Each institution will be awarded an additional \$1,000 to professionals who successfully enrolls 10 or more teens into a program listed on FindYourSummer.org
