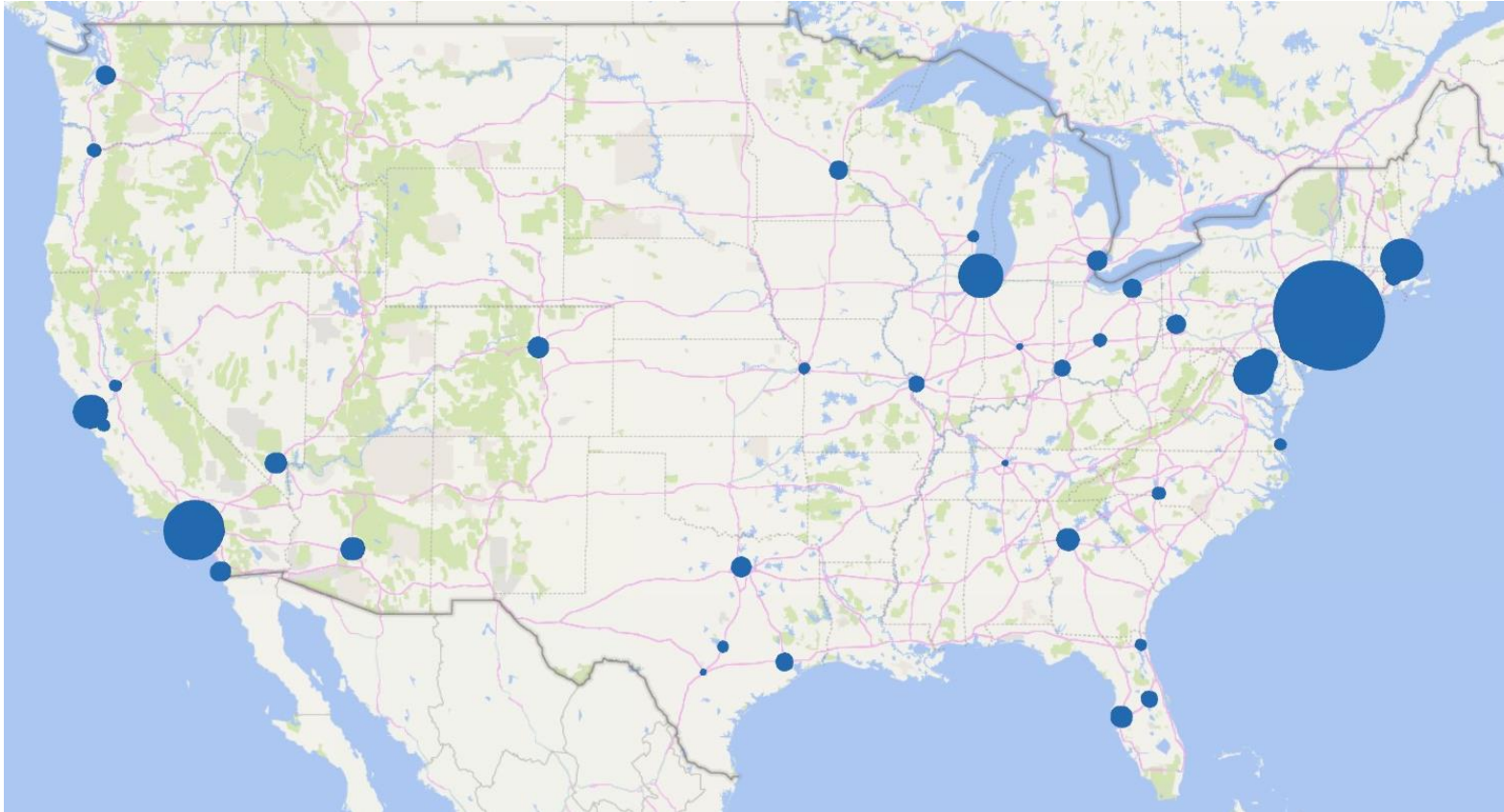


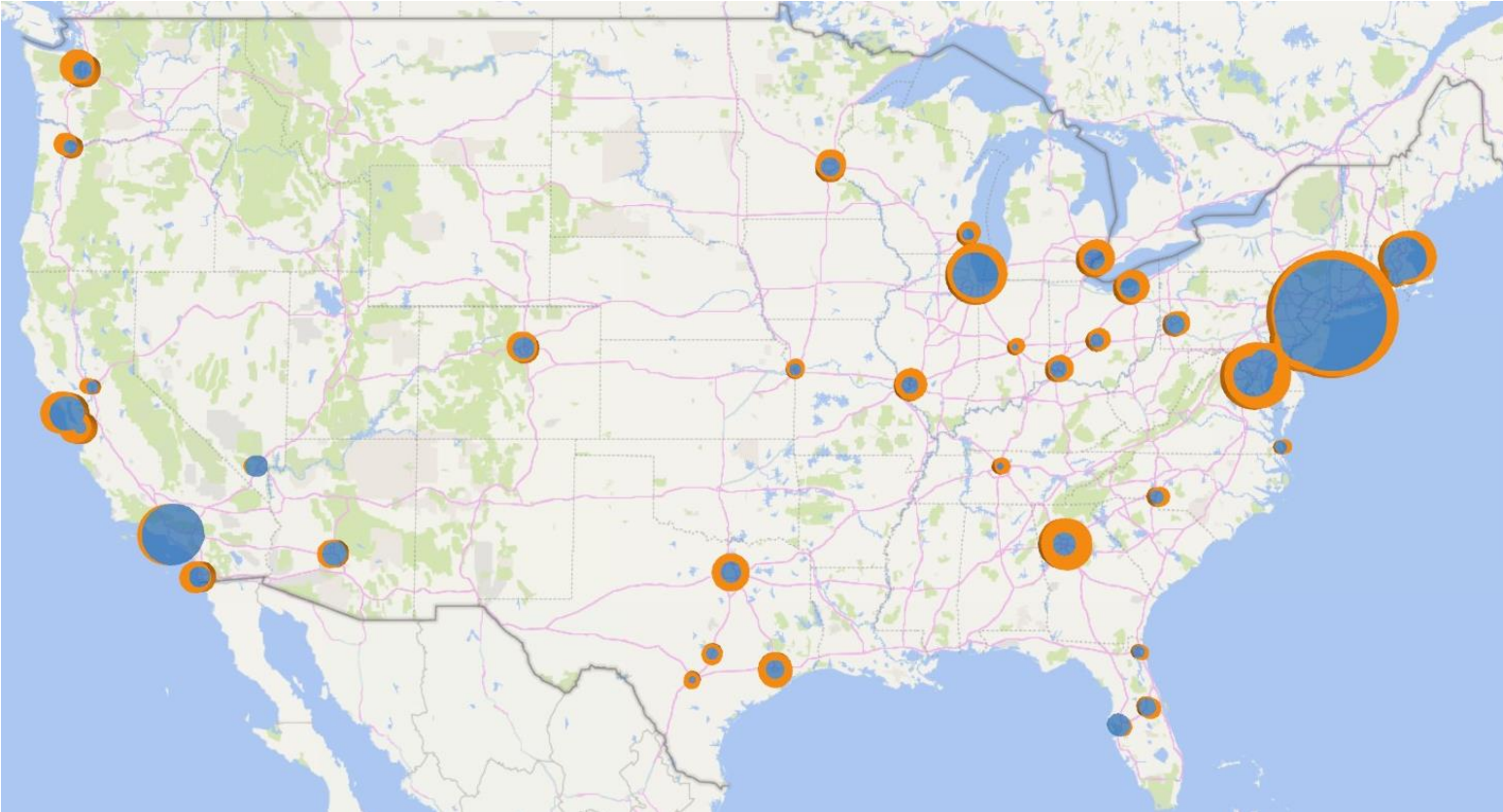

# Top Jewish Population by U.S. Metro Areas



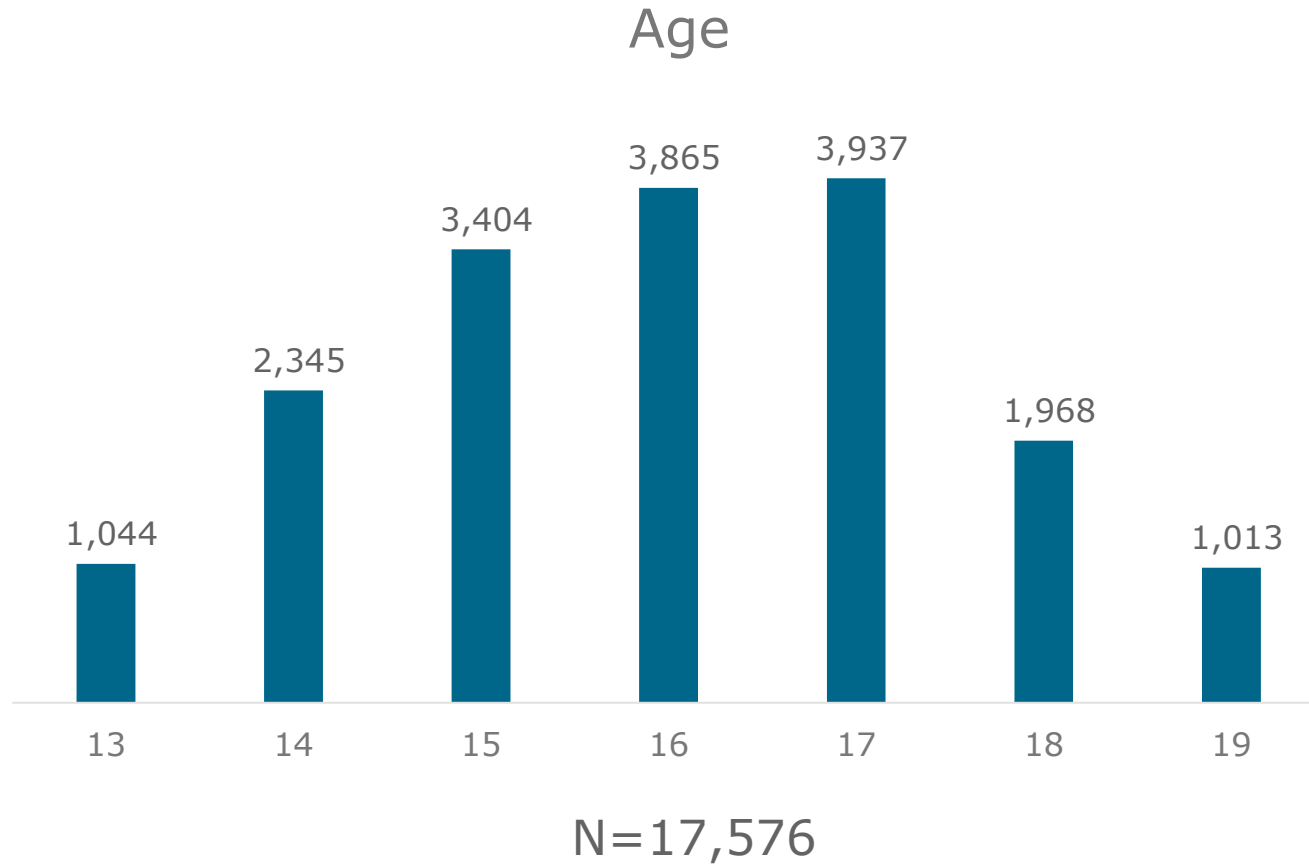
This map represents the largest concentrations of the North American Jewish Population according to SSRI at Brandeis.

# Top Jewish Population by U.S. Metro Areas

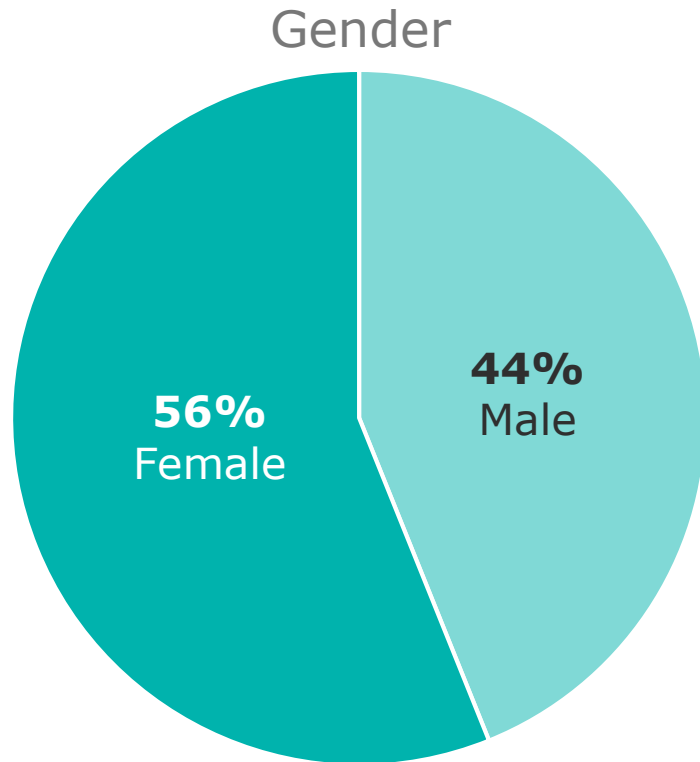


In this map, the blue is still the population distribution (Steinhart), and the orange represents the concentration of respondents from our survey.
