**Mensch-ify**, a parenting and pre-K to 3rd grader Jewish "how to" experience, guides parents on how to raise Jewish *mensches*, kind and compassionate Jewishly-engaged children, while simultaneously providing primary-level supplemental Jewish learning for these pre-K to 3rd graders.

By utilizing Jewish text and tradition, participants, clergy and faculty apply these stories and commentaries to develop kindness, compassion and motivation to improve the world.

This 8-month, 15-session Sunday morning family

experience creates a supportive community and Jewish second homes for current congregants who are interfaith, Jewish or under-engaged in the Jewish community.

A simultaneous, optional learning component for 4th-6th grade older siblings is available. Students learn from Or Ami and local teens who are considered every day heroes for the mensch work they do. Students participate in mitzvah projects, learn about heroes in Torah stories and local organizations that provide tangible ways to act Mensch-y.
