The successful candidate will develop and implement project plans and budgets to deliver expected results, set direction and prioritize work across numerous projects, while aligning goals and delivering timely results. S/he/they will coordinate logistics and project management support, as well as internal reporting that drives KPIs for the full RootOne team.

- Lead key cross-departmental projects
- Leverage project management tools to manage day-to-day operations, automate tasks, ensure quality, and promote process efficiencies.
- Determine and define clear deliverables, roles, and responsibilities for required for specific projects or initiatives.
- Manage project communications and process adherence across multi-disciplinary teams and with leadership and other key stakeholders, including progress meetings and regular reporting.
- Understand project scope and prevent scope creep.
- Monitor shifts in timing, deliverables, budgets, and resources while communicating potential impacts.
- Develop and manage project timelines, stages, and benchmarks to complete the deliverables.
